**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about January 14, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**JOHN PARRILLA,  
a/k/a John Torres,  
a/k/a "Johnny,"**

attempted to enter the TD Bank (the bank), located at 2520 Grant Avenue in Philadelphia, with intent to commit in the bank, a felony affecting the bank, that is, to knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, take, from employees of the TD Bank, currency of the United States, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the TD Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
