INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 3, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**ALFREDO ALBERTO ALMEIDA-URIAS,
a/k/a “Joel Valdez,”
a/k/a “Angel Morales,”**

an alien and native and citizen of Mexico, who had been previously removed from the United States on or about May 3, 1999, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered and attempted to re-enter the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for

admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), (b)(1).
