NEWS RELEASE

Acting United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a two-count indictment¹ charging STEVEN GILBERT with possession with intent to distribute marijuana and attempted distribution of marijuana. These charges arose when GILBERT, through his employment as a U.S. Postal letter carrier, received packages containing approximately 65 pounds (30 kilograms) of marijuana through the U.S. mail and attempted to deliver it.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a mandatory minimum of 2 years up to a lifetime of supervised release, a \$500,000 fine, and a \$200 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Service, Office of the Inspector General and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Denise S. Wolf.
