NEWS RELEASE

Acting United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a three-count indictment¹ charging NAZARIO AGUILAR MARTINEZ with escape from a federal facility and assaulting a federal officer. These charges arose when MARTINEZ absconded from the custody of the Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security and when he forcibly resisted Deportation Officers when found.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 19 years imprisonment, 3 years supervised released, a \$600,000 fine, and a \$225 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Denise S. Wolf.
