NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy today announced the unsealing of an eight-count Indictment¹ charging Gabriell Phillips, Felicia Phillips and Kiesha Roberts with conspiracy to distribute crack cocaine and distribution of crack cocaine in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The indictment alleges that the conspiracy lasted for a three-month period beginning in February 2009 and ending in May 2009.

If convicted, Gabriell Phillips faces up to life imprisonment, a mandatory minimum sentence of life imprisonment, an \$8,000,000 fine, and an \$800 special assessment. Felicia Phillips and Kiesha Roberts each face up to life imprisonment, a mandatory minimum sentence of 10 years imprisonment, a mandatory minimum of 5 years up to a lifetime of supervised release, a \$4,000,000 fine, and an \$800 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Bucks County Violent Gang Task Force, and is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Richard Kornylak.
