**SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about February 10, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**TIMOTHY W. STROBL**

knowingly possessed books, magazines, periodicals, films, video tapes and other matter, namely one Compaq Armada M700 laptop computer and one IBM Model DHEA-36480 computer hard drive, which contained more than 600 visual depictions that had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

**COUNTS TWO THROUGH FIFTEEN**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about the following dates, in Nazareth, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, the defendant

**TIMOTHY W. STROBL**

employed, used, persuaded, induced, enticed, and coerced, and attempted to employ, use, persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, the below-listed minors to engage in sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing a visual depiction of that conduct and the visual depiction was produced using materials that had been sent by mail and shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce:

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(4) and 2251(a) set forth in this superseding indictment, defendant

**TIMOTHY W. STROBL**

shall forfeit to the United States of America any visual depiction described in Sections 2252 (a)(4) or 2251 and any matter containing such depictions, and any property used or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to promote the commission of such offenses as charged in this superseding indictment, including, but not limited to:
