COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 4, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendants

**DAMIEN YOUNG and
ROSHID MILLEDGE**

boarded, and aided and abetted the boarding of, an aircraft intended for air transportation, that is, U.S. Airways Flight Number 1195 from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, destined for Phoenix, Arizona, with a concealed dangerous weapon in defendant YOUNG's his carry-on baggage, that is, a Smith & Wesson 9-millimeter semi-automatic handgun, serial number RAT5785, that is and would be accessible to defendant YOUNG in flight, and defendant MILLEDGE, a U.S. Airways employee, smuggled the handgun through an employees' entrance into Philadelphia International Airport.

In violation of Title 49, United States Code, Section 46505(b)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE


THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:
