THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 5, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Citizens Bank, 2014 Cottman Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,710, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a)._____

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 12, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Citizens Bank, 2910 Cottman Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,081, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a)._____

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 20, 2008, in Clementon, in the District of New Jersey,
defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of TD Bank, 1235 Blackwood-Clementon Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$200, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of TD Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 28, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Citizens Bank, 9218 Frankford Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$3,600, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SIX

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 7, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the PNC Bank, 3201 Willits Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$4,801, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of PNC Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SEVEN

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 21, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM KUSZNIR

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of PNC Bank, 2401 Welsh Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$4,090, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of PNC Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
