A Gatlinburg, Tennessee man, Greg Hruby, was charged today, by information¹, with perjury before the federal grand jury, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. According to the information, on or about March 8, 2007, while under oath in a proceeding before a federal grand jury of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, the defendant knowingly made false declarations in response to questions asked to him with respect to matters that were material to the grand jury.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of five years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, three years of supervised release and a \$100 special assessment.
