INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 8, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

FARON BRUCE MAY

forcibly assaulted, resisted, opposed, impeded, intimidated and interfered with officers of the
United States, as designated in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1114, that is, United States
National Park Service Ranger B.P., while Ranger B.P. was on-duty, in uniform, and engaged in
the performance of his official duties.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 111(a)(1).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 8, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

FARON BRUCE MAY

forcibly assaulted, resisted, opposed, impeded, intimidated and interfered with officers of the
United States, as designated in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1114, that is, United States
National Park Service Ranger J.H., while Ranger J.H. was on-duty, in uniform, and engaged in
the performance of his official duties.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 111(a)(1).
