NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy today announced the filing of a one-count indictment¹ charging Terrance Williams with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. The indictment alleges that on April 22, 2009, Williams, a convicted felon, possessed an Israeli Military Industries Uzi Eagle .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, loaded with seven rounds of ammunition.

If convicted the defendant faces a statutory maximum sentence of life imprisonment, including a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of fifteen years, a \$250,000 fine, five years supervised release, and \$100 special assessment.

This case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives. This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Karen M. Klotz.
