INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 21, 2009, in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

EDWARD B. WEBB

knowingly and intentionally attempted to possess with intent to distribute approximately 990 pills containing a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of Oxycodone ("OxyContin"), a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title, 21 United States Code, Section 841(a)(1),(b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 28, 2009, in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

EDWARD B. WEBB

knowingly and intentionally attempted to possess with intent to distribute approximately 1,013 pills containing a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of Oxycodone (“OxyContin”), a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title, 21 United States Code, Section 841(a)(1),(b)(1) (C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy today announced the filing of a two-count Indictment ¹ against Edward B. Webb charging that Webb attempted, on two occasions, to possess with intent to distribute a total of over 2000 of OxyContin pills.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE DEFENDANTS

Edward B. Webb	Allentown, Pennsylvania	1967

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 40 years imprisonment, a fine of \$ 2 million, a mandatory minimum of 3 years up to lifetime supervised release, and a special assessment of \$200.

The case was investigated by Immigration and Customs Enforcement, an agency within the United States Department of Homeland Security and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Floyd J. Miller.
