INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

At all times material to this indictment:

1. The Autozone, Inc. store ("Autozone") located at 1730 Washington Street

in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, was engaged in the retail sale of automotive replacement parts and accessories and was an enterprise that affected interstate commerce.

2. On or about March 4, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of

Pennsylvania, defendant

TREVOR ALSTON

obstructed, delayed, and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that defendant ALSTON unlawfully took and obtained money, that is, approximately \$2,500 in United States currency, in the presence of employees of Autozone and against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence,

and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their persons and property in their possession, that is, by brandishing a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 4, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

TREVOR ALSTON

knowingly used and carried, and aided and abetted the use and carrying of, a firearm, that is, a semi-automatic pistol, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, robbery, which interfered with interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES:

1. Paragraph 1 of Count One of this indictment is incorporated here.

2. On or about April 1, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

TREVOR ALSTON

obstructed, delayed, and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that defendant ALSTON unlawfully took and obtained money, that is, approximately \$1,100 in United States currency, in the presence of employees of Autozone and against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their persons and property in their possession, that is, by brandishing a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 1, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of

Pennsylvania, defendant

TREVOR ALSTON

knowingly used and carried, and aided and abetted the use and carrying of, a firearm, that is, a semi-automatic pistol, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, robbery, which interfered with interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).
