**NEWS RELEASE**

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy announced the filing of an indictment<sup>1</sup> against Ramiro Avila-Avila, a/k/a “Ramiro Avila,” a/k/a “Roberto LNU,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation. The indictment alleges that on or about August 5, 2009, Avila-Avila was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about January 3, 2006.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
