COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 6, 2009, in Boothwyn, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendants

THOMASINA PRECIOUS TRENT, and DESHAWN DOMINQUE ROGERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the TD Bank branch located at 657 Conchester Highway, and aided and abetted the unlawful taking by force and violence and intimidation, lawful currency of the United States, that is, \$4,404, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the TD Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and 2.

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 7, 2009, in Brookhaven, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendants

THOMASINA PRECIOUS TRENT, and DESHAWN DOMINQUE ROGERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the First Keystone Bank branch located at 3218 Edgemont Avenue, and aided and abetted the unlawful taking by force and violence and intimidation, lawful currency of the United States, that is, \$2,948, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the First Keystone Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and 2.
