INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 8, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

HIRAM JOSEPH ADAMS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took, from employees of Wachovia Bank, located at 1700 Market Street, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$626, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Wachovia Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 21, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

HIRAM JOSEPH ADAMS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took, from employees of Valley Green Bank, located at 7226 Germantown Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$6,999, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Valley Green Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 4, 2010, in Cheltenham Township, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

HIRAM JOSEPH ADAMS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took, from employees of Citizens Bank, located at 1000 Easton Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$6,772, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 28, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

HIRAM JOSEPH ADAMS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, attempted to take, from employees of Citizens Bank, located at 8616 Germantown Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 4, 2010, in Springfield Township, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant


HIRAM JOSEPH ADAMS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took, from employees of Sovereign Bank, located at 800 E. Willow Grove Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$568, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Sovereign Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
