NEWS RELEASE

A superseding indictment¹ was unsealed today charging Charles Bernhardt, Yusef Davis, and Garland Crump with conspiracy to sell counterfeit currency and possessing and selling counterfeit currency, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. According to the indictment, the three defendants conspired to sell more than \$10,000 of counterfeit \$100 bills between March and May of 2010.

If convicted, Yusef Davis faces a maximum possible sentence of 105 years in prison and a fine of \$1,500,000; Garland Crump faces a maximum possible sentence of 45 years in prison and a fine of \$750,000; and Charles Bernhardt faces a maximum possible sentence of 85 years in prison and fine of \$1,250,000.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney David J. Ignall.
