NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Lorenzo Juarez-Mundo, a/k/a “Lorenzo Mundo,” a/k/a “Lorenzo Gomez,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about November 10, 2010, Juarez-Mundo, an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about April 25, 2006.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
