INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 12, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY WAYNE RANSOM

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 2516 Welsh Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,055, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 19, 2010, in Abington, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY WAYNE RANSOM

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the PNC Bank, located at 123 Old York Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$4,050, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the PNC Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 12, 2010, in Abington, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY WAYNE RANSOM

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the FirstTrust Bank, located at 261 Old York Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$680, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the FirstTrust Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 17, 2010, in Abington, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY WAYNE RANSOM

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the TD Bank, located at 710 Old York Road, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,600, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the TD Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FIVE

On or about June 27, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY WAYNE RANSOM,

having been committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the United States following his conviction of a felony in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, knowingly and without authorization, escaped and remained absent from the Luzerne Residential Reentry Center, that is, the federal institution or facility to which the defendant was confined by the Attorney General of the United States.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 751(a).
