**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2010, in Trevoese, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(D).

**COUNT TWO**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevoise, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute five grams or more, that is, approximately 5.87 grams of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(B).

**COUNT THREE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevose, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(D).

**COUNT FOUR**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevoze, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

**COUNT FIVE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevoze, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

**COUNT SIX**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevoise, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a “Tim,”**

knowingly possessed a firearm, that is, a black Taurus, 9 mm pistol, serial number TTE13691, loaded with one round of 9mm ammunition, in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, distribution of marijuana, and possession with intent to distribute cocaine base (“crack”), marijuana, heroin, and cocaine, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).

**COUNT SEVEN**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about December 8, 2009, in Trevose, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a "Tim,"**

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a black Taurus, 9 mm pistol, serial number TTE13691, loaded with one round of 9 mm ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(c), as set forth in this indictment, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a “Tim,”**

shall forfeit to the United States of America, the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of these offenses, including, but not limited to:

- (a) a loaded black Taurus, 9 mm pistol, serial number TTE13691; and
- b) one round of 9 mm ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).

2. As a result of the violations of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

**RALPH J. CAMACHO,  
a/k/a “Tim,”**

shall forfeit to the United States of America:

(a) any property used or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to:

- i. a loaded black Taurus, 9 mm pistol, serial number TTE13691,
- ii. one round of 9 mm ammunition; and
- iii. approximately \$6,833 in United States currency; and

(b) any property constituting, or derived from, proceeds obtained directly or indirectly from the commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to, the sum of \$6,833.

3. If any of the property subject to forfeiture, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the property subject to forfeiture.

All pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.
