# COUNT ONE

# THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 4, 2010, in Reading, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount

of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

# COUNT TWO

### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 13, 2010, in Reading, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount

of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

# **COUNT THREE**

### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 15, 2010, in Reading, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount

of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

### **COUNT FOUR**

### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 4, 2010, in Reading, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

#### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable

by

imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a LLAMA .380 caliber handgun, serial number B57887, loaded with six rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

#### **COUNT FIVE**

### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 13, 2010, in Reading, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

#### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable

by

imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Beretta .22 caliber handgun with an obliterated serial number, loaded with five rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

#### **NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

#### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violations of Title 21, United States Code, Section
841(a)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

### **DOMINIC MOSLEY**

shall forfeit to the United States of America:

- (a) any property used or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of, such offenses, including, but not limited to:
  - (1) one LLAMA .380 caliber handgun, serial number B57887;
  - (2) six .380 caliber rounds;
  - (3) one Beretta .22 caliber handgun with an obliterated serial number; and
  - (4) five rounds of .22 caliber ammunition.
  - (b) any property constituting, or derived from, proceeds obtained

directly or indirectly from the commission of such offenses.

2. If any of the property subject to forfeiture, as a result of any act or

omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant(s) up to the value of the property subject to forfeiture.

All pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.

3. As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section

922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

### DOMINIC MOSLEY

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of these offenses, including, but not limited to:

- (a) one LLAMA .380 caliber handgun, serial number B57887;
- (b) six .380 caliber rounds;
- (c) one Beretta .22 caliber handgun with an obliterated serial number; and
- (d) five rounds of .22 caliber ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18,

United States Code, Section 924(d).
