**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

Beginning on or about June 8, 2009, and continuing through on or about June 9, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**VANESSA PEREZ,  
a/k/a "Lala,"**

having attained the age of 18 years, and not being in any category enumerated in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1201(g)(1)(B)(ii), knowingly, willfully, and unlawfully seized, confined, kidnaped, abducted, carried away, and held T.P., a person known to the grand jury who had not attained the age of 18 years, for ransom, reward, or otherwise, that is, for the purpose of gaining a personal benefit from that seizure, and willfully transported T.P. in interstate commerce from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to Germantown, Maryland.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1201(a)(1), (g).
