An Indictment¹ was filed today against Antine Robinson charging him with one count of possessing a firearm after having been convicted of a felony, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

If convicted of the charge, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of ten years imprisonment, a fine of \$250,000, three years of supervised release, and a special assessment of \$100.

This investigation and prosecution is part of *Project Safe Neighborhoods*, a joint initiative by the United States Attorney's Office, each of the nine District Attorney's Offices in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and other federal, state and local law enforcement agencies to identify and prosecute dangerous firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendants are likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction.

The case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Andrew J. Schell.
