NEWS RELEASE

Today, Angel Cintron was charged in a three-count indictment¹ with distribution of cocaine, possession with intent to distribute 28 grams or more of cocaine base (“crack”) and possession of a firearm in furtherance of drug trafficking, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on August 4, 2010, Cintron distributed a mixture and substance containing cocaine, in Philadelphia. The indictment further charges that on September 23, 2010, Cintron possessed with intent to distribute approximately 50.7 grams of cocaine base (“crack”), and possessed a loaded Ruger 9mm semi-automatic pistol in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime in Philadelphia. If convicted, Cintron faces a maximum penalty of life imprisonment, an aggregate mandatory minimum term of 10 years imprisonment, 4 years supervised release, a \$3,250,000 fine, and a \$300 special assessment.
