NEWS RELEASE

A two-count information¹ was filed today charging Ian Golden with conspiracy to commit bank robbery, bank robbery, and aiding and abetting, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The charges arise out of the theft of a Franklin Mint Federal Credit Union ATM machine from the Delaware County Memorial Hospital on September 7, 2009.

If convicted of all charges, the defendant faces a total maximum sentence of 25 years imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, a \$500,000 fine, and a \$200 special assessment.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and several suburban police departments. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Salvatore L. Astolfi.
