COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 26, 2010, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

HENRY JACKSON

knowingly possessed certain matter, namely computers and external hard drives, which contained visual depictions that had been shipped and transported using a means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).
