COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On on or about March 26, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

NORMAN LEBOON

threatened to assault and to kill Eric Cantor, a United States Congressman and a United States official, with intent to impede, intimidate, interfere with, and retaliate against Congressman Cantor, while he was engaged in his official duties and on account of the performance of his official duties.

In violation of Title 18 United States Code, Section 115(a)(1)(B).

COUNT TWO

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 26, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

NORMAN LEBON

transmitted in interstate commerce a communication, that is, a YouTube video over the internet, containing a threat to kill Congressman Eric Cantor and a member of his family.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 875(c).
