NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was unsealed today, charging Emmanuel Moore, Theodore McFadden, Sr. and Monique Pearson Moore with conspiracy to distribute 5 kilograms or more of cocaine, attempted possession with intent to distribute of 3 kilograms or more of cocaine, and unlawful use of a communications facility, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.
