NEWS RELEASE

Bristol Alloys, Inc. and its president, James Bullick, were charged today by Information¹ with one count of Major Fraud Against the United States, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. According to the information, the defendants were in the business of selling metal to various customers, including a U.S. Navy subcontractor who supplied parts used to build, among others, Virginia Class submarines. According to the information, the defendants fraudulently supplied a Navy subcontractor with metal that did not conform to required military specifications and provided counterfeit certifications that purportedly showed that the metal had been heat treated in accordance with the contract requirements when, in fact, as the defendants knew, no such heat treatment had occurred.

If convicted, defendant Bristol Alloys, Inc. faces a maximum possible sentence of five years probation, a \$5 million fine, mandatory restitution, and a \$400 special assessment. If convicted, defendant James Bullick faces a maximum possible sentence of 10 years imprisonment, a three year period of supervised release, a \$5 million fine, mandatory restitution, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Naval Criminal Investigative Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney John J. Pease.

¹An Indictment or Information is an accusation. A defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
