NEWS RELEASE

Emmanuel Duran, a/k/a “Manny, ” a/k/a “Manny Yunk,” Raheem Brown, a/k/a “Heem,” John Bowie, a/k/a “Heads,” Joshua Hines and Kevin Staten, a/k/a “Donnell Staten,” a/k/a “Nell,” were charged today in a 28-count indictment¹ with six armed robberies of pharmacies in Philadelphia, the distribution of the narcotics stolen from the pharmacy robberies, and the possession of firearms during the period of February 8, 2010 through June 9, 2010, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The pharmacies robbed are as follows:
