NEWS RELEASE

Rassan Johnson was charged today, in a one-count indictment ¹, with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

If convicted, defendant faces a maximum sentence of ten years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, and three years supervised release.

This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction.

This case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Ewald Zittlau.
