INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 4, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

RASSAN JOHNSON,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable
by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate
commerce a firearm, that is: (1) a Ruger SR9, 9mm semiautomatic pistol, serial number
obliterated, loaded with eleven rounds of live ammunition; and (2) a DPMS AR-15 rifle, .223
caliber, model C-15, serial number C1119.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

RASSAN JOHNSON

shall forfeit to the United States of America, the firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of such offense including, but not limited to: (1), a Ruger SR9, 9mm semiautomatic pistol, serial number obliterated; and (2) a DPMS AR-15 rifle, .223 caliber, model C-15, serial number C1119; and (3) eleven rounds of live ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
