COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 3, 2010, in Blandon, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

GREGORY A. VULLINGS

knowingly possessed a laptop computer which contained more than 600 visual depictions that had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE
