PRESS RELEASE

Anthony Wiggins was charged today by information¹ with conspiracy to commit access device fraud, access device fraud, and aggravated identity theft, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

According to the information, between July 2009 and September 2009, the defendant participated in a conspiracy to use stolen account information and fraudulent drivers' licenses to purchase merchandise at stores.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE DEFENDANTS

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 17 years imprisonment, including a two year mandatory term of imprisonment, three years of supervised release, a \$750,000 fine, and a \$300 special assessment.

The case was jointly investigated by the U.S. Postal Service and the U.S. Secret Service, with assistance from the Cheltenham Township Police Department. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Laurie Magid.
