NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Juan Diaz-Gomez, a/k/a “Daniel Montero-Vega,” a/k/a “Daniel Karos,” a/k/a “Juan Diaz,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. The indictment alleges that on or about March 18, 2010, Diaz-Gomez was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about August 6, 2008 and September 22, 2008.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of two years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
