**NEWS RELEASE**

An indictment<sup>1</sup> was filed today against David Alexander Dominguez-Navarro, a/k/a “David Alex Navarro,” a/k/a “Alex A. Acosta,” a/k/a “Alex David Navarro,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. The indictment alleges that on or about March 23, 2010, Dominguez-Navarro was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about October 30, 2006.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
