William M. Ford, Shawn Edwards, Timothy Victor-Canty, Christopher Victor-Canty, and Andre Taylor were charged today by Indictment¹ with conspiracy, bank fraud, and aggravated identity theft, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy.

If convicted, the defendants face a maximum possible sentence of 30 years per count of bank fraud, five years per count of conspiracy, and a mandatory two-year sentence for each count of aggravated identify theft.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service, the Philadelphia Police Department, and the Bucks County Detectives, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Nancy E. Potts.
