NEWS RELEASE

A ten-count superseding indictment¹ was filed today charging Dominique Johnson, Jerry Taylor, Amin Dancy, and Christopher Montague with multiple armed bank robberies, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. Dominique Johnson is charged in all five of the armed bank robberies and the other defendants are charged in one or more of the armed bank robberies allegedly committed during this bank robbery spree. The indictment charges the defendants with the armed robberies of the following banks: the 5-2-09 armed robbery of the Wachovia Bank at 628 Gravel Pick in East Greenville, the 5-29-09 armed robbery of the Wachovia Bank at 6420 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, the 7-3-09 armed robbery of the Wachovia Bank at 762 Bristol Pike in Bensalem, the 7-17-09 armed robbery of the TD Bank at 2200 Garrett Rd in Upper Darby, and the armed robbery again on 7-31-09 of the Wachovia Bank at 628 Gravel Pick in East Greenville.

If convicted, Johnson faces a mandatory minimum sentence of 57 years up to a maximum of life; Taylor faces a mandatory minimum sentence of 32 years in prison up to a maximum of life; Dancy faces a mandatory minimum sentence of seven years in prison up to a maximum of life; Montague faces a maximum sentence of 30 years in prison.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorneys Alicia Freind and Nancy Beam Winter.
