INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 30, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

RAPHAEL MCNAMARA-HARVEY,
a/k/a Raphael McNamara,
a/k/a Rapheal McNamara,
a/k/a Raphael al - Sammouni McNamara,

having been convicted in a court of the State of New Jersey of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a destructive device (an improvised incendiary device) as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 921(a)(4)(A) and (C).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 30, 2009, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,

defendant

**RAPHAEL MCNAMARA-HARVEY,
a/k/a Raphael McNamara,
a/k/a Rapheal McNamara,
a/k/a Raphael al - Sammouni McNamara,**

knowingly received and possessed a firearm, that is, a destructive device (an improvised incendiary device), not registered to him in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record.

In violation of Title 26, United States Code, Sections 5845(a), 5861(d), and 5871.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), and Title 26, United States Code, Sections 5845(a), 5861(d), and 5871, as set forth in this indictment, defendant


**RAPHAEL MCNAMARA-HARVEY,
a/k/a Raphael McNamara,
a/k/a Rapheal McNamara,
a/k/a Raphael al - Sammouni McNamara,**

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm, that is, an improvised incendiary device, involved in the commission of these offenses.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
