INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

1. On or about September 11, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

LAMAR PALMERO,
a/k/a "Marty,"

and Abdul Fowler and Eric Williams, charged elsewhere, conspired and agreed, together and with others known to the grand jury, to commit an offense against the United States, that is, to knowingly and unlawfully commit armed robbery of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, located at 9212 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, PA, the deposits of which were insured by the National Credit Union Administration, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(d).

MANNER AND MEANS

2. It was part of the conspiracy that defendant LAMAR PALMERO, Abdul Fowler, Eric Williams, and others known to the grand jury, committed an armed robbery of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, 9212 Frankford Avenue, Philadelphia, PA, and stole approximately \$20,651.

OVERT ACTS

In furtherance of the conspiracy, defendant LAMAR PALMERO, Abdul Fowler, Eric Williams, and others known to the grand jury, committed the following overt acts, among others, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania:

On or about September 11, 2007:

1. Defendant LAMAR PALMERO and Abdul Fowler and Eric Williams and others known to the grand jury traveled to the Sun East Federal Credit Union located at 9212 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, PA.

2. Defendant LAMAR PALMERO and Eric Williams went inside the bank and stole approximately \$20,651 in United States currency at gunpoint, while Abdul Fowler waited outside in the getaway car.

3. Defendant LAMAR PALMERO and Abdul Fowler and Eric Williams, and other persons known to the grand jury, fled from the bank.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 371.

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

1. Paragraph 2 and Overt Acts 1 through 3 of Count One of this indictment are incorporated here.

2. On or about September 11, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**LAMAR PALMERO,
a/k/a "Marty,"**

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took, and aided and abetted the taking from employees of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, 9212 Frankford Avenue, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$20,651, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, the deposits of which were insured by the National Credit Union Administration, and in so doing, defendant PALMERO knowingly and unlawfully assaulted and put in jeopardy the lives of the employees of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, and other persons, by use of semi-automatic handguns.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(d) and 2.

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

1. Paragraph 2 and Overt Acts 1 through 3 of Count One of this indictment are incorporated here.

2. On or about September 11, 2007, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**LAMAR PALMERO,
a/k/a "Marty,"**

knowingly used and carried, and aided and abetted the use and carrying of, a firearm, that is, two semi-automatic handguns, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, conspiracy to commit armed bank robbery and armed bank robbery, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 371 and 2113(d).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(c)(1) and 2.
