INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

INTRODUCTION

The Defendants and their Prostitution Enterprise

At all times material to this indictment:

1. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," a/k/a "Jose Claudio," a/k/a "Felimon," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," a/k/a "Raymond Gonzalez," Hispanic males, controlled and operated a prostitution enterprise from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, that used an interstate network of Hispanic females to provide sexual services to male customers for a fee.

2. The prostitution enterprise controlled by defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU#2, a/k/a "JOHNNY" provided prostitution services in "house," that is, in brothels set up in various residential locations in South Philadelphia, including addresses at 1221A South 7th Street, and 1314 South 6th Street. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY" also provided a prostitution "delivery" service, where customers ordered prostitutes by phone. The prostitutes were then delivered to the male customer at the location the customer requested by a driver working for defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY." The customers were charged a cash amount of \$30 for 15 minutes with the prostitute at the brothel location or through the delivery service. Prostitution services were provided on a daily basis from Monday through Saturday from approximately 11 a.m. to approximately 11 p.m., and on Sunday until approximately 5 p.m.

3. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," recruited, coordinated and scheduled prostitutes to travel to Philadelphia from New York, New Jersey and Delaware, among other states, to work as prostitutes for this business enterprise. The females lived in the brothels primarily for a week at a time while they worked as prostitutes in "house" or for "delivery." Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," brought in three new women on a weekly basis to service the customers. The prostitutes were paid a cash amount at the end of the week based on the number of customers serviced. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY" and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," controlled the cash receipts generated from the enterprise and authorized payment to the prostitutes.

4. Defendant FNU LNU#3, a/k/a "NICO," a/k/a "Nicolas Gonzalez Salazar," a Hispanic male, worked for defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU

District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, defendants

6. From in or about August 2009, to in or about January 2010, in the Eastern

and escorted the prostitutes from the brothel and prepared them for delivery to the customers. Defendant FNU LNU #4, a/k/a "ROJO," also escorted customers to the brothel from the street, which included controlling access to and from the brothel by customers and the prostitutes. #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," serving as a doorman for the brothel at the 1221A South 7th Street, Rubio," a Hispanic male, worked for defendants FNU LNU #1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU

driving the prostitutes to the customers who ordered the delivery service, and collecting cash customer calls for prostitutes, processing customer phone requests for the delivery service, #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," serving the prostitution enterprise in various ways, including handling

interstate cellular telephone facilities to promote, manage and carry on an unlawful activity, that is a business enterprise involving prostitution, in violation of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Title 18, Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes Annotated, Section 5902, and performed and attempted to perform acts to promote, manage, carry on, and facilitate the promotion, management, and carrying on of the unlawful activity, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1952(a)(3); and

(b) To persuade and induce female aliens to travel in interstate commerce to engage in prostitution and sexual activity, for which any person can be charged with a criminal offense, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2422(a).

MANNER AND MEANS

It was part of the conspiracy that:

7. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," used various residential locations in South Philadelphia, including addresses at 1221A South 7th Street and 1314 South 6th Street, to operate as brothels, from which defendants conducted a prostitution enterprise, using Hispanic females to provide sexual services for male customers in exchange for cash.

8. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," provided prostitution services "in house" at the brothel locations, and also provided a prostitution "delivery" service, where orders for the females were placed by telephone to cell phones controlled by defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," and FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO." The prostitutes were delivered to the customers at the location designated by the customer by defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," who served as a driver.

Deliveries of prostitutes were made to customers primarily in Philadelphia, as well as parts of Delaware County. A customer was charged the rate of \$30 in cash for 15 minutes with the prostitute, at the brothel location "in house," or through the delivery service.

9. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," routinely scheduled three new females to arrive each week in Philadelphia to work for their prostitution business. The females who worked for defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," were of Hispanic ethnicity and arrived in Philadelphia by bus, primarily from New York City. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," scheduled and arranged for the females to arrive at the Greyhound Bus Terminal at 10th and Filbert Streets in Philadelphia (Greyhound Bus Terminal), where the females were picked up by the defendants FNU LNU #1, a/k/a "RICKY" or FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," and transported to the brothel located at 1221A South 7th Street. Two of the females were assigned to work in the brothel location and one of the females was assigned to work the delivery service. After a week, the females were transported back to the Greyhound Bus Terminal in Philadelphia to return to New York City, and elsewhere.

10. The prostitutes lived at the brothel locations for the time they worked for defendants FNU LNU #1, a/k/a "RICKY" and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY." The females' access to and from the brothel location at 1221A South 7th Street was controlled by defendant FNU LNU #4, a/k/a, "ROJO."

11. Prostitution services were provided at the brothel locations and through the delivery service from approximately 11 a.m. to approximately 11 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and until approximately 5 p.m. on Sunday. Customers called specific cellular

telephone numbers which accessed defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," and FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," to arrange for delivery service or to obtain the location of the brothel. Business cards were distributed on the street to customers providing the telephone numbers to call for the services. Customer access to and from the brothel location at 1221A South 7th Street was controlled by defendant FNU LNU #4, a/k/a "ROJO."

12. Defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," and FNU LNU #4, a/k/a "ROJO," kept track of the number of customers serviced by the prostitutes through "punch cards" or "tickets" that were maintained by defendant FNU LNU #4, a/k/a "ROJO," to provide a weekly talley of the number of customers serviced per prostitute. At the end of the week, the prostitutes were paid in cash by defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," based on the number of customers serviced. Approximately sixty to seventy different females worked for the defendants' prostitution enterprise between approximately August 2009 to January 2010.

13. Cellular telephones were used by defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," to coordinate the scheduling of the prostitutes and their arrival in Philadelphia from New York City and elsewhere on a weekly basis; to arrange the transportation of the prostitutes from the bus terminal in Philadelphia to the brothel locations; to field customers calls for prostitutes and arrange the services for customers; and to coordinate operations with the driver, defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," and the doormen, defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO."

14. Approximately \$9,000 per week was generated in proceeds from the prostitution services provided by the enterprise operated by defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a

“RICKY,” FNU LNU #2, a/k/a “JOHNNY,” FNU LNU #3, a/k/a “NICO,” and FNU LNU #4, a/k/a “ROJO.”

OVERT ACTS

In furtherance of the conspiracy, defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a “RICKY,” FNU LNU #2, a/k/a “JOHNNY,” FNU LNU #3, a/k/a “NICO,” FNU LNU #4, a/k/a “ROJO,” and others known and unknown to the grand jury, committed the following overt acts in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere:

1. On or about August 3, 2009, at approximately 2:21 p.m. , defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a NICO, picked up an unidentified Hispanic female at the brothel location, 1221A South 7th Street, and transported the female to 23rd and Diamond Street in Philadelphia for a prostitution delivery.
2. On or about August 9, 2009, commencing at approximately 2:26 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a “NICO” transported an unidentified Hispanic female to a series of locations in Philadelphia for prostitution deliveries.
3. On or about August 10, 2009, at approximately 12:17 p.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a “RICKY,” picked up an unidentified Hispanic female at the Greyhound Bus Terminal at 10th and Filbert Streets in Philadelphia (“Greyhound Bus Terminal”) and transported the female to the brothel location at 1221A South 7th Street in Philadelphia.
4. On or about August 17, 2009, at approximately 10:35 a.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a “RICKY,” picked up an unidentified Hispanic female at the Greyhound Bus Terminal and transported the female to the brothel location at 1221A South 7th Street.

5. On or about August 17, 2009, at approximately 11:19 a.m., defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," picked up an unidentified Hispanic female from the area of the Greyhound Bus Terminal and transported the female to the above brothel location.

6. On or about August 31, 2009, at approximately 11:17 a.m., defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," picked up an unidentified Hispanic female arriving by bus from New York City, New York to the Greyhound Bus Terminal and transported the female to the brothel location at 1221A South 7th Street at approximately 11:27 a.m.

7. On or about September 25, 2009, a cooperating individual, working at the direction of agents with Immigration & Customs Enforcement ("ICE") and posing as a prostitute, placed a consensually monitored telephone call to a cell phone used by defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," bearing number (215) 668-1923, to make arrangements to work for FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," as a prostitute. Defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," asked the caller, if she wanted to work "house" or "delivery," and stated that he would need "one female" and instructed the caller to call him on Sunday between "11 and 12."

8. On or about September 25, 2009, an undercover officer, working with ICE and posing as a customer, placed a consensually monitored telephone call to a cell phone used by defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," bearing number (267) 322- 9965, and asked where to go for a woman. Defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," told the undercover to go to "7th and Federal" and then call him. Defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," told the undercover that it would cost "30."

9. On or about October 25, 2009, at approximately 1:30 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," using cell phone bearing number 215 -668-1923, spoke to a

Hispanic female named "Ruby" who identified herself to be "Venezuelan" and willing to work "delivery." Defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," told "Ruby" to call defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," when she arrived at the Greyhound Bus Terminal in Philadelphia from 42nd Street and defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," would pick her up.

10. On or about October 27, 2009, at approximately 9:52 p.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," using cell phone bearing number 267-266-4983, spoke to defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," using cell phone number 267-322-9965, and directed defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," to do "deliveries" with unidentified Hispanic female called "Connie." Defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," stated he would bring another female to Delaware.

11. On or about October 29, 2009, at approximately 2:40 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," using cell phone bearing number 267-322-9965, spoke to an unidentified Hispanic male who wanted "girls." Defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO" replied that he had "three" and they were Venezuelan, Columbian and Dominican and they were available for "delivery."

12. On or about November 1, 2009 at approximately, 11:10 a.m., defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," using cell phone bearing number 215-668-1923, spoke to a Hispanic female called "Mariella", who called defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," to "report" herself. Defendant" FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," instructed her to buy a ticket and take the 8 a.m. bus from New York to Philadelphia and to call defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," when she arrived in Philadelphia and he will pick her up.

13. On or about November 4, 2009, at approximately 10 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," using cell phone bearing number 267-322-9965, spoke to an unidentified

Hispanic male who asked how many women defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," could bring for delivery to which defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," replied he could bring a Salvadoran who is 25 and that the charge is "30." The male stated that the three of them each wanted a woman.

14. On or about November 24, 2009 at approximately 8:14 p.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," using cell phone bearing number 267-266-4983, spoke to defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," using cell phone bearing number 267-974-2474, about setting up a new brothel location in the Upper Darby area of Delaware County because the area is good at night. Defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," stated it was important to give it another name so it is not associated with "them."

15. On or about November 28, 2009 at approximately 12:36 p.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," using cell phone bearing number 267-266-4983, spoke to defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO," using cell phone bearing number 267-702-7345, and provided defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO," with the number for a customer and instructed defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO," to send the "girl."

16. On or about November 30, 2009, at approximately 3:11 p.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," using cell phone bearing number 267-266- 4983, spoke to defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO," using cell phone bearing number 267-702-7345, and directed defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO," to meet two customers at 7th and Federal Streets in Philadelphia and further stated that he defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," would be there with "the girl."

17. On or about November 30, 2009, at approximately 5:26 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," using cell phone bearing number 267-974-2474, spoke to an

unidentified Hispanic male who stated he was calling from South Philadelphia and wanted to know what defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," had "right now," to which defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," stated he had a "Salvadoran" for delivery and that "she was good." Defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," directed the caller to 7th and Wharton and told the caller to call defendant FNU LNU #3, a/k/a "NICO," who would then get him.

18. On or about December 6, 2009, at approximately 12:44 p.m., defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," using cell phone bearing number 215-668-1923, spoke to a Hispanic female called "Creny" who called defendant FNU LNU#2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," about whether defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," needed "one." Defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," replied that he needed one for the "house" and for "delivery." Defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," instructed "Creny" to take the 8 a.m. bus to Philadelphia and to arrive no later than 10:30 a.m., and further stated that he would pay her "fare" once she arrived in Philadelphia.

19. On or about December 7, 2009, at approximately 10:44 a.m., defendant FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," using cell phone bearing number 267-266-4983, spoke to a prostitute "Jenny" and directed her from the Greyhound Bus Terminal to a minivan driven by defendant FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," who transported "Jenny" to the brothel at 1221A South 7th Street, where she was escorted into the brothel by defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO."

20. On or about December 14, 2009, at approximately 12:15 p.m., a prostitute "Adriana" met defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a "RICKY," and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a "JOHNNY," in the vicinity of the Greyhound Bus terminal and was transported by a minivan to the brothel at

1221A South 7th Street and escorted into the brothel by defendant FNU LNU#4, a/k/a "ROJO.

All in violation of Title 18 United States Code Section 371.

COUNTS TWO THROUGH EIGHT

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

1. Paragraphs 1 through 5 and 7 through 14 of Count One are realleged.
2. On or about the dates set forth below, in the Eastern District of

used and caused to be used, and aided and abetted the use of, a facility in interstate commerce, that is, interstate cellular telephone communications between the defendants FNU LNU#1, a/k/a “RICKY,” and FNU LNU #2, a/k/a “JOHNNY,” and the female prostitutes with the intent to promote, manage, and carry on, and facilitate the promotion, management, and carrying on, of unlawful activity, that is a business enterprise involving prostitution, in violation of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Title 18, Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes Annotated, Section 5902, and thereafter performed and attempted to perform acts to promote, manage, carry on, and facilitate the promotion, management, and carrying on, of unlawful activity, each cellular telephone communication constituting a separate count:


