NEWS RELEASE

Jesus Sotelo-Sosa, a/k/a "Julio Hernandez Castro," a/k/a "Arturo Garcia," was charged today by Indictment¹ with illegally reentering the United States after having been deported, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. The indictment alleges that on or about December 9, 2009, Sotelo-Sosa was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about June 19, 1998, and September 19, 2006.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Michael J. Fischer.
