**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

1. At all times material to this indictment, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY was a citizen of the United States. Defendant BEY was born in April 1977.
2. In approximately 2005, in Egypt, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY entered into a union purporting to be an Islamic marriage with T.Y.D., a minor female whose name is known to the grand jury. T.Y.D. was approximately fourteen years old at the time and was born in August 1990.
3. From approximately 2005 through approximately 2007, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY engaged in a sexual relationship with T.Y.D. in Egypt, including sexual intercourse.
4. On or about February 21, 2006, in Egypt, when T.Y.D. was fifteen years old, she gave birth to a son, Y.O.B., whose name is known to the grand jury. Defendant OMAR

RASHAAD BEY is Y.O.B.'s biological father and the child was conceived by defendant BEY and T.Y.D. in Egypt in 2005 when T.Y.D. was fourteen years old.

5. On or about April 15, 2008, in Egypt, when T.Y.D. was seventeen years old, she gave birth to a daughter, T.O.B., whose name is known to the grand jury. Defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY is T.O.B.'s biological father.

6. T.S.D., whose name is known to the grand jury, is T.Y.D.'s older sister. T.S.D. was born in February 1989.

7. In approximately 2004 through 2005, in Egypt, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY engaged in a sexual relationship with T.S.D. in Egypt, including sexual intercourse. During this time, T.S.D. was less than sixteen years old.

8. From on or about January 1, 2004, through on or about May 6, 2004, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY,**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt for the purpose of engaging in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with a person less than 16 years of age.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(b).

**COUNT TWO**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraphs one through seven of Count One are incorporated here.

2. From on or about July 6, 2004, through on or about November 19, 2004, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY,**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt for the purpose of engaging in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with a person less than 16 years of age.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(b).

**COUNT THREE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraphs one through five of Count One are incorporated here.
2. From on or about March 27, 2005 through on or about May 23, 2006, in

the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY,**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt for the purpose of engaging in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with a person less than 16 years of age.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(b).

**COUNT FOUR**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraphs one through five of Count One are incorporated here.
2. From on or about January 1, 2004, through on or about August 2006, in

the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce to Egypt, and while in Egypt, engaged in illicit sexual conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f), with T.Y.D., a person less than 16 years old whose name is known to the Grand Jury.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(c).

**COUNT FIVE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraphs one, six and seven of Count One are incorporated here.
2. From on or about January 1, 2004, through on or about February 2005, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt, and while in Egypt, engaged in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with T.S.D., a person less than 16 years old whose name is known to the Grand Jury.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(c).

## COUNT SIX

### **THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraph one of Count One is incorporated herein by reference.
2. In 2006, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY entered into a union purporting to be an Islamic marriage with A.G., a minor female whose name is known to the grand jury. A.G. was approximately fifteen years old at the time and was born in May 1991. During this Islamic marriage ceremony, A.G. was located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY was communicating during the ceremony via an internet video hookup.
3. On or about August 24, 2006, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY traveled with A.G. from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Cairo, Egypt.
4. From approximately August 2006 through approximately May 2007, defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY engaged in a sexual relationship with A.G. in Egypt, including sexual intercourse. During this time, A.G. was fifteen years old.
5. On or about March 20, 2007, in Egypt, when A.G. was fifteen years old, she gave birth to a son, A.O.B. whose name is known to the grand jury. Defendant OMAR RASHAAD BEY is A.O.B.'s biological father.

6. From on or about August 24, 2006, through on or about May 2007 in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, defendant

**OMAR RASHAAD BEY,**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt for the purpose of engaging in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with a person less than 16 years of age.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(b).

**COUNT SEVEN**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. Paragraph one of Count One and paragraphs one through five of Count Six are incorporated here.
2. From on or about August 24, 2006, through on or about May 2007, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant


**OMAR RASHAAD BEY**

a United States citizen, traveled in foreign commerce, from the United States to Egypt, and while in Egypt, engaged in illicit sexual conduct (as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(f)), with A.G., a person less than 16 years of age whose name is known to the Grand Jury.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(c).
