NEWS RELEASE

An indictment<sup>1</sup> was filed today charging Roy Allen Bowman with one count of pharmacy burglary, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. According to the indictment, the defendant burglarized the Walgreen's Pharmacy at 7001 Frankford Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on February 13, 2010, with intent to steal materials and compounds containing any quantity of a controlled substance, including but not limited to, Oxycodone, Ritalin, Hydromorphone, Oxymorphone, Methadone, and Morphine, all Schedule II controlled substances, and whose replacement value was not less than \$500.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of 20 years in prison, three years of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Philadelphia Police Department. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Thomas M. Zaleski.
