THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 15, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

MARCOS CASTILLO

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising the La Escuelita Academy, a private school, grades pre-K through 5th, at 2896 N. 5th Street, the real property comprising the Fairhill School, a public school grades K through 8th, at 601 W. Somerset Street, and the real property comprising the Julia DeBurgos School, a public school, grades pre-K through 8th, at 401 W. Lehigh Avenue, all in Philadelphia, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 860, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 3147.

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 25, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

MARCOS CASTILLO

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 3147.

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 25, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

MARCOS CASTILLO

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising the La Escuelita Academy, a private school, grades pre-K through 5th, at 2896 N. 5th Street, the real property comprising the Fairhill School, a public school grades K through 8th, at 601 W. Somerset Street, and the real property comprising the Julia DeBurgos School, a public school, grades pre-K through 8th, at 401 W. Lehigh Avenue, all in Philadelphia, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 860, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 3147.

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about February 3, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

MARCOS CASTILLO

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 3147.

COUNT SIX

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about February 3, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

MARCOS CASTILLO

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising the La Escuelita Academy, a private school, grades pre-K through 5th, at 2896 N. 5th Street, the real property comprising the Fairhill School, a public school grades K through 8th, at 601 W. Somerset Street, and the real property comprising the Julia DeBurgos School, a public school, grades pre-K through 8th, at 401 W. Lehigh Avenue, all in Philadelphia, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 860, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 3147.
