### NEWS RELEASE

Jurel Daniel was charged today in a two-count indictment alleging that in August and October of 2007 he straw purchased two handguns from a Lancaster County firearms dealer, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy and Lancaster County District Attorney Craig Stedman.

This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative to identify and prosecute firearm offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction. If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of ten years in prison, a \$500,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
