**NEWS RELEASE**

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy today announced filing an Indictment\* against **Mark T. Isley and Richard Goode** charging that Goode possessed cocaine and heroin with intent to distribute within 1,000 feet of a public high school. Isley has been charged as being a felon in possession of a firearm. According to the indictment, on March 10, 2010, Goode possessed narcotics near the Stephen A. Douglas Magnet School in Philadelphia, and Isley possessed a loaded Smith and Wesson 9mm semi-automatic pistol. A deputized federal agent assigned to the FBI was seriously injured while making the arrest.

If convicted of all charges, Isley faces a maximum possible sentence of life imprisonment as a career criminal, a \$500,000 fine and 3 years supervised release. Goode faces a maximum sentence of 40 years imprisonment, a mandatory minimum 1 year in prison, a \$6,000,000 fine and a mandatory minimum of 9 years up to lifetime supervised release.

The case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, an initiative by the United States Attorney’s Office, the Philadelphia District Attorney’s Office, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Philadelphia Police Department to identify and prosecute firearms and narcotics offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction. The case is being prosecuted by Special Assistant United States Attorney Joseph Whitehead, Jr.
