INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 7, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

IDRIS MANIOR,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Smith & Wesson, Model 422, .22 caliber semi-automatic pistol (Serial Number TBJ7836), loaded with eight rounds of CCI .22 caliber ammunition recovered as spent shell casings.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

IDRIS MANIOR

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:

1. The Smith & Wesson .22 caliber handgun (Serial Number TBJ7836); and
2. Eight fired cartridge casings.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
