NEWS RELEASE

An indictment<sup>1</sup> was filed today against Idris Manior charging him with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. The indictment alleges that on June 7, 2009 Manior possessed a Smith & Wesson, Model 422, .22 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial number TBJ7836, and eight rounds of CCI .22 caliber ammunition recovered as spent shell casings.

This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction.

If convicted, Manior faces a maximum possible sentence of 10 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, up to 3 years supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Neuman Leverett.
