INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 13, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH BAER

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the PNC Bank branch, located at 6855 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1000, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the PNC Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 16, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH BAER

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Trumark Financial Credit Union, located at 1811 JFK Boulevard in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$641, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Trumark Financial Credit Union, the deposits of which were insured by the National Credit Union Administration.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 19, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH BAER

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 2101 Cottman Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,550, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 13, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

JOSEPH BAER,

having been committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the United States following his conviction of a felony in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, knowingly and without authorization, escaped and remained absent from the Luzerne Community Corrections Center, that is, the federal institution or facility to which the defendant was confined by the Attorney General of the United States.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 751(a) and 4082(a).
